**Subject matter and
area covered:**

The Local Plan identifies land and allocates sites for different types of development, such as housing and employment, to deliver the planned growth for Central Lincolnshire to 2036. It also covers a wide range of other planning related matters, in the form of policies, for use, primarily, in the determination of planning applications. It also allocates certain areas for protection (such as Local Green Spaces). It covers the whole of Central Lincolnshire (i.e. the whole of West Lindsey, City of Lincoln and North Kesteven districts).
