Thank you for the update.

Whilst many 'infrastructure' mentions are in place, I have grave concerns that the correct level of very needed infrastructure would ever happen. Since the report was lodged, far too many cuts have been published regarding maintenance of street lighting, grass cutting and Highways roads, etc. This does not give confidence that corner cutting of infrastructures will not happen.

In addition, further increases since the report was lodged show that more housing has been included in the local plan. As an example in Skellingthorpe where I live, c100 homes have been added to the already one third increase planned and is currently happening in the village. Whilst future houses are needed, even in Skellingthorpe, real infrastructure is required and not just words. Concrete agreements need to be agreed and implemented.
