

SustainNK Competition

Terms and Conditions



This is a North Kesteven District Council Service

1. To enter the competition correct and sufficient information must be completed for entry to be considered. This includes the entrants full name, age, and a means of contact (phone number, email or postal address)
2. Competitions run in the name of SustainNK are only available to people registered to receive the SustainNK quarterly newsletter.
3. Competitions run by SustainNK are available only to current NKDC residents.
4. Competitions are only open to NK residents aged 18 or over.
5. As stipulated by the prize provider (SoperBMW, Roman Way, South Hykeham, LN6 9UH), the BMW i8 experience day is only available to residents aged 25 or over, with a full clean UK driving licence. The winner can be accompanied by one passenger.
6. If the winner does not meet the criteria at 5, they can transfer the prize to someone who does meet this criteria and accompany them as a passenger.
7. Entries can be made by email (sustainnk@n-kesteven.gov.uk), phone (01529 414155), or post (SustainNK competition, North Kesteven District Council, Kesteven Street, Sleaford, Lincolnshire, NG34 7EF)
8. One entry, and the first entry received, per person will be entered into the draw.
9. The closing date for entries is midnight Saturday 2nd June 2019 and late entries will not be considered.
10. Entries received after the closing date will not be included in the competition. The Council will not be responsible for any entries that are not received for any reason, by the closing date, whether lost, delayed, corrupted, defaced, illegible or otherwise, and whether or not due to any technical difficulties or malfunctions, or any other problem with any server or internet access. Proof of dispatch of entries will not be accepted as proof of receipt.
11. The competition is open to employees and Councillors of NKDC, but excludes NKDC's Sustainability Initiatives Officer and any staff directly connected with administering the competition.
12. The Sustainability Initiatives Officer has the right to exclude any entry on reasonable grounds.
13. The winner(s) are picked at random from all eligible entries.
14. There is no cash alternative
15. If the winner(s) declines the prize or cannot be contacted within two weeks, it will be offered to the next randomly selected eligible entry at the discretion of the Sustainability Initiatives Officer.
16. The Sustainability Initiatives Officer reserves the right to cancel or suspend the competition without notice.
17. The Sustainability Initiatives Officer will take measures to ensure receipt of the prize but cannot guarantee delivery by Soper BMW. The Sustainability Initiatives Officer will not accept responsibility for failure of delivery due to, but not limited to: conditions out of NKDC and SoperBMW's control, incorrect address.
18. Only winners will be notified. Winners' details will be available on the North Kesteven District Council website or by contacting the Sustainability Initiatives Officer.

19. The Sustainability Officer will process personal details for entry into the competition. All personal details are held in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998. We will only use your information for the purposes of administration of the Competition and any other purposes to which you have consented e.g. to receive the SustainNK newsletter. We will not pass your details on to any third party.
20. Personal details are stored beyond the end date of the competition. They are only available to the Sustainability Initiatives Officer for the purposes of sending the SustainNK newsletter.

Terms and conditions for SustainNK newsletter

1. Entrants to SustainNK competitions are consenting to their data being used to receive the SustainNK newsletter by email or post 4 times a year. The purpose of holding personal contact details is solely to distribute the newsletter.
2. Where a recipient does not have an email address available a copy will be sent by post. All postal recipient names and postal addresses are stored on the Council's database. E-newsletter recipients details are stored on Mailchimp (see 5 and 6 for more details).
3. The newsletter is only available to NKDC residents.
4. Recipients can unsubscribe at any time using the unsubscribe feature on the e-newsletter or by contacting the Sustainability Initiatives Officer.
5. The newsletter is designed and issued by NKDC's Communications Team and the Sustainability Initiatives Officer in hard copy and via an online newsletter design software company Mailchimp www.mailchimp.com.
6. Mailchimp is a registered trademark of The Rocket Science Group. Email addresses for recipients are stored within Mailchimp on a secure server and are only accessible and usable in relation to the SustainNK newsletter. The Sustainability Officer and Communications Team have password access to the website account.
7. You are signing up to an e-newsletter from North Kesteven District Council using a third party system which is outside of the European Union in the United States of America and as such different national laws apply to how your data is stored.
8. The third party is committed to an international framework where data is secured to the same or higher standards of the European Union. Information will only be used for North Kesteven District Council and will not ever be sold or used by any other third party.
9. Contact details are only stored and used in relation to the SustainNK newsletter. All data is held in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998. Contact details are only stored and used in relation to the SustainNK newsletter. Appropriate security measures and procedures are in place and all data will be kept no longer than necessary.
