

Data Protection Impact Assessment Stage 1

The following statements will help you decide whether a DPIA is necessary: Please tick all that apply

Will it ask or compel people to provide information about themselves (e.g. name, postal address, email address)?

Will it involve the collection of new information about people?

Will information about people be disclosed to third parties (i.e. other organisations or people) who have not previously had access to this data?

Are you using information about people for a purpose that it is not currently used for (e.g. re-using an emailing list to promote Council services)?

Will you be using new technology which might be perceived as being privacy intrusive (e.g. CCTV, profiling)?

Will this result in you making decisions or taking action against people in ways which can have a significant impact against them (e.g. conducting consultation and the results of which could affect their locality)?

Is the information about people likely to raise privacy concerns (e.g. health records, data regarding ethnicity or racial origin, religious or philosophical beliefs, political opinions, trade union membership, sexual orientation or other information people would consider to be particularly private)?

Will it require you to contact people in ways that they may find intrusive?
