## **Lincolnshire Hate Crime Survey**



Hate incidents and hate crime are acts of violence or hostility directed at people because of who they are or who someone thinks they are.

For example, you may have been verbally abused by someone in the street because of a disability or you may be bullied due to your sexual orientation.

If you've experienced a hate incident or hate crime you can report it to either,

- The Police on 101 or
- -Stop Hate UK on 0800 138 1625

The Police and Crown Prosecution Service have agreed a common definition of hate crimes.

They say something is a hate incident if the victim or anyone else thinks it was motivated by hostility or prejudice based on one of the following things:

- Race
- Identified gender
- Disability
- · Ethnicity and Religion
- Sexual orientation

This means that if you believe something is a hate incident it should be recorded as such by the person you are reporting it to. All police forces record hate incidents based on these personal characteristics.
