


WARD PROFILES

A step by step guide for sourcing custom ward 2011 Census data from the Official Labour Market Statistics (NOMIS) and the Office for National Statistics (ONS).

NOMIS 'Ward 2011 Census Statistics'

Step 1: Click https://www.nomisweb.co.uk/

The link will take you to the NOMIS page located on the ONS website, as shown below.




Step 2:

On the bottom right-hand corner of the screen locate the purple box titled "Census Statistics" and click on "2011 Search by topic (table finder)" related to 2011 Census, as shown below:

Step 4:



2011" which can be found at the top of the list:




Step 7:



On the top left-hand side of the screen locate the grey box titled "Labour Market Profiles" and click on "2011 Ward Profile", as shown below:




In the search box "choose a local authority" from the drop down box, for example "North Kesteven", as shown below:

On the right-hand side of the screen you will see the map of your chosen local authority, as below:




Step 4:
