Electors must show photo ID to vote in a polling station from 4 May 2023



Guide to applying for a Voter Authority Certificate

If you are registered to vote but do not have suitable photo ID, then you can apply for a free Voter Authority Certificate. This Certificate is a new free voter photo document you can use to vote in person at a polling station.


You cannot use it as proof of identification for any other reason. You should apply for a Voter Authority Certificate if:

- you do not have accepted photo ID
- you no longer look like the photo on your ID
- the name on your photo ID is significantly different to your name on the electoral register.

Applying by paper form?

Before you complete the paper application form for a Voter Authority Certificate, please check the following information:

- You are registered to vote at your current address with the same name as shown on your ID. If you're not registered to vote or you need to change your name or address on the electoral register, you will need to register to vote before applying for a Voter Authority Certificate. Please get in touch with customer services to request details on how to register to vote.
- You will need to know your date of birth and your National Insurance number - you can still apply if you cannot provide a National Insurance number, but you will need to provide supporting documents and it may take longer to process your application.
- You will need a recent photo to go with your Voter Authority Certificate application form.
 - » You can provide a hardcopy photo or email a digital photo to elections@n-kesteven.gov.uk or
 - » NKDC customer services can take your photo for you. They can also assist you to complete the application online at GOV.UK if you would like help. Book an appointment at the NKDC Sleaford office by phone on 01529 414155 or email customer_services@n-kesteven.gov.uk
 - » You need to provide a suitable photo showing your head and shoulders with your face uncovered. The full list of photo requirements are shown on page 4 of the application form.
- Once completed you can return your paper form together with a hardcopy photo either in person or post to NKDC, Kesteven Street, Sleaford, NG34 7EF.
