

PUBLIC NOTICE

LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SLEAFORD - GRANTHAM ROAD, KING EDWARD STREET AND QUEEN STREET) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) AMENDMENT ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council has made an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting as set out in the Schedule below.

Proposed Waiting Restrictions.

- No Waiting at Any Time - On Grantham Road in the vicinity of (Numbers 62-64)
- Formalization of No Waiting at Any Time - On the junction of King Edward Street and Queen Street and on Grantham Road in the vicinity of (Numbers 76-82)

Exemptions are included which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.

The Order will come into operation on 26th January 2024 and a copy of the Order and a plan showing the lengths of road concerned with a Statement of Reasons can be requested.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks after 22nd January 2024 make application to the High Court for this purpose.
