Matter 5 – Energy, Climate Change and Flooding

- 2) Reducing Energy Consumption**
 - Whether or not the Plan is consistent with paragraph 154(b) of the Framework, which states that any local requirements for the sustainability of buildings should reflect the Government’s policy for national technical standards.
 - Whether or not the requirement to generate at least the same amount of electricity used over the course of a year from renewable sources on-site (and preferably on-plot) is justified.
 - Whether or not the requirements for new residential development have been adequately tested, alongside other planning policy costs, to determine their impact upon viability.

 - Is Policy S9 consistent with national planning policy in paragraph 155 of the Framework which states that Plans should identify opportunities for development to draw its energy supply from decentralised, renewable or low carbon energy systems. Decentralised energy is defined by the Framework as local renewable and local low carbon energy sources.

 - Whether or not the Map of Areas Suitable in Principle for the development of medium-large wind turbines is justified and effective, having particular regard to landscape and heritage constraints?

- Whether or not the approach to best and most versatile agricultural land in Policy S14 is justified and internally consistent with other policies in the Plan.
