

Central Lincolnshire Five Year Land Supply Report (January 2019): Housing Delivery Test Results – Erratum

Following the publication of the Central Lincolnshire Five Year Land Supply Report in January 2019, the Government published its Housing Delivery Test (HDT) Results in February 2019.

Table 4, under paragraph 3.11 on page 5 of the Five Year Land Supply Report set out the anticipated results of the HDT at the time of publication in the absence of the official Government results, which were due out in November 2018. These were:

2016/17	976	924	94.7%
2017/18	978	1,102	112.7%
Total	2,938	2,959	100.7%

The figures from Table 4 were predictions only and, in light of the publication of the Government's figures, these official results should now be used as follows:

Year	Requirement	Delivered	Percentage
2015/16	976	1,177	120.6%
2016/17	970	933	96.2%
2017/18	961	1,135	118.1%
Total	2,907	3,245	111.6%

These changes do not affect the five year land supply calculation as in both cases there has not been a persistent under-delivery of housing in Central Lincolnshire, and so the 5% buffer should be applied.
