Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004

Statement of the adoption of the Central Lincolnshire Local Plan (a Development Plan Document) and publication of the Inspectors' Report

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with regulations 17 and 26 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, that the Central Lincolnshire Joint Strategic Planning Committee (CLJSPC) adopted on 24 April 2017 the Central Lincolnshire Local Plan Development Plan Document (DPD), under the provisions of section 23 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended).

The Central Lincolnshire Local Plan DPD identifies land and allocates sites for different types of development, such as housing and employment, to deliver the planned growth for Central Lincolnshire to 2036.

Any person aggrieved by the DPD may make an application to the High Court under section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that:

- (a) the document is not within the appropriate power;
- (b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with.

Any such application must be made not later than the end of the period of six weeks starting from the date of adoption (date of adoption was 24 April 2017).

The DPD was the subject of an independent examination by an Inspector (supported by a second Inspector) from the Planning Inspectorate, and the recommendations of the Inspectors, and reasons, are set out in the form of an Inspectors Report. The Inspectors' Report has been published in accordance with section 20(8) of the Act. The adopted version of the DPD includes all the main modifications recommended by the Inspectors.
