

UKSPF Sleaford Shopfront Grant Scheme

**Grants are available
for shopfront
improvements within
Sleaford town centre.**

Key points

- The aim of the scheme is to improve the historic environment of Sleaford town centre and Sleaford Conservation Area
- Grants will be focussed on shopfronts but can extend to other elements of building frontages
- A total fund of £150,000 is available and grants can be offered at up to 90% of the total cost of works
- The scheme is funded by the UK Shared Prosperity Fund and managed by North Kesteven District Council



Grants available

Grants of up to 90% of the cost of eligible works will be available. Priority will be given to the installation of traditional shopfronts in order to restore the character of a building. Grants can also be offered for other works such as the replacement and repair of doors, replacement fascias and signage and other external works including brick and stonework cleaning and repainting.



Eligible works

- Reinstatement of traditional shop fronts
- Replacement or repair of windows and doors (including upper floor windows)
- Roof repairs
- Repairs/renewal of leadwork
- Repair or replacement of rainwater goods
- Structural and non-structural repairs to external walls
- Brickwork/stonework cleaning and repainting
- Repair of external features such as masonry
- Repair or replacement of shopfront fascias and signage (in line with the Sleaford Shopfront Design Guide)
- Associated works preliminaries and professional fees
