

Before making a planning application, you can discuss your proposal with us to find out whether the principles of your proposal are acceptable or not in planning terms. This service provides the following:

- Confirmation as to whether or not planning permission is required
- Which planning policies and other constraints affect your proposal
- An officer's informal view on the proposal if permission is required

Our advice will be based on the information you provide on this form and any additional details submitted. Therefore the more detailed information you can give about the proposal, the more informal planning advice we can provide on what you are intending to do. The checklist on the following page identifies the basic information that is needed in order to advise you.

We cannot provide informal advice that is binding on the Council. Any views or opinions will be given in good faith without prejudice to the formal planning application process which will be subject to public consultation. This service cannot guarantee that any subsequent applications will be valid or that they will be approved. This pre-application service aims to help identify issues that may be raised should a planning application be submitted so that they can be properly considered prior to an application being made.


Information required in support of your enquiry

Site location plan

The site should be edged red on the site location plan.

A sketch layout

The sketch layout should clearly show the existing property along with where the proposals are to be sited. Distances from boundaries should be marked along with any other constraints, such as trees. Trees in neighbouring garden areas or on separate land which are within the vicinity of the site should also be shown on the block plan. Roads, footpaths and public rights of way should also be identified.



Existing Details

Existing elevation details must be submitted. These may be in the form of drawings to a recognised scale (e.g. 1:50 or 1:100) or sketch drawings which have been annotated with metric dimensions. Annotated photographs can be used to show the existing property.





Proposed Details

Proposed elevation details must be submitted. These may be in the form of drawings to a recognised scale (e.g. 1:50 or 1:100) or sketch drawings which have been annotated with metric dimensions. Catalogue and specification details provided by suppliers (e.g. conservatories and sheds etc) can also be submitted to help describe the proposal.









PROPOSED -REAR **ELEVATION**
