

Terms and Conditions – Riverlight Stamp Competition

1. Entrants into the Riverlight Stamp Competition shall be deemed to have accepted these Terms and Conditions and to comply fully with them
2. For those under the age of 18, the relevant part of the form should be completed with your parent/guardian's name and contact details
3. You, or your parent or guardian, can submit the form to this competition via the Postbox found at the Hub/National Centre for Craft and Design
4. Entry to the Riverlight Stamp Competition is restricted to one entry per person
5. Personal contact details will be used for the purpose of administering the Riverlight Stamp Competition
6. The Riverlight Stamp Competition will run from Saturday 15 June 2024 to Saturday 22 June 2024. All entries must be submitted by the closing date and any entries received after this date will not be considered
7. The Council accepts no liability or responsibility for entries that are lost, mislaid, damaged, delayed or undelivered, regardless of cause
8. Unsuccessful entrants will not be contacted and there is no obligation to feedback on any entry
9. An internal announcement will be made on Wednesday 26 June 2024 with prizes awarded to winning entries
10. The Council's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into
11. There will be ten prizes, which will be drawn at random
12. The prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and is not redeemable for cash or any other prize
13. The Council accepts no responsibility for any damage, loss, liabilities, injury or disappointment incurred as a result of entering into the prize draw or accepting the prize
14. Winners will be contacted within 28 days of the announcement (internal announcement to be made on Wednesday 26 June 2024)
